Sub: Academic activities for class IX during the current academic session(February & March 2010)-school based evaluation-reg

Sir/Madam,

In pursuance of guidelines laid down by CBSE and KVS HQ in various letters, the following steps need to be taken by the schools.

1. Unit tests 1 & 2 shall be deemed as Formative Assessment 1 & 2. Term Test I (Half-yearly examination) shall be deemed as Summative I.
2. Unit test 3 shall be construed as Formative Test III.
3. Formative Test IV will have to be conducted in all subjects. It may please be noted that at least one formative test needs to be other than through the pen/paper test. Schools will have to conduct Formative Test IV through other assessment tools. A broad list of other assessment tools is available in CBSE's website in the CCE corner. However, for the sake of convenience, a sample tool for each subject is listed below:
  - a. Languages- oral communication
  - b. Science and math- lab activities
  - c. Social Sciences- projects
4. Formative Test IV needs to be completed before 28<sup>th</sup> February.
